

New Zealand Programming Contest 2021

WEBSITE

As you may remember, the previous website has had to be taken down. Basic functionality is provided through a smaller site on a different server. <http://www.nzprogcontest.org.nz> will take you to the working site.

CONTEST

The contest will be held on **Saturday September 11th at 2pm.**

If the Covid-19 alert level permits, it will be held at each of the sites across the country. If the alert level does not permit gatherings at sites, then the contest will be held online.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be done on the day through DOMjudge.

For an on site contest, teams who register in the wrong category must notify organisers in the first hour of the contest. After that they will be placed in the **higher** of the category chosen and the category intended.

Reservation

Team managers may use the website to reserve places at one of the sites. Teams who turn up without reserving spaces will be accommodated only if there is room.

CATEGORIES

For an on site contest, the normal categories will apply. These may be modified for an online contest depending on how many sites are still available.

Teams are categorised by the most senior contestant.

| Name | Description | Entry Fee |
|-----------------------|---|-----------|
| School | Pupils at a secondary school in New Zealand. Includes home schools. | \$30 |
| Tertiary Junior | First year students. They must not have taken or be taking any paper at level 6 or higher. | \$75 |
| Tertiary Intermediate | Second year students. They must not have taken or be taking any paper at level 7 or higher. | \$75 |
| Tertiary Open | Any other tertiary students, including postgraduates. | \$75 |
| Open | Any other contestants, including professional programmers. | \$120 |
